- 1 Submit a local [government proclamation](#): Proclamation templates and specific instructions are available.
- 2 Distribute [educational materials](#) to patients and referring physicians: Conveniently download or simply request free prints of posters and brochures.
- 3 Join the [NPAD Thunderclap campaign](#), a pre-crafted social media message to be mass-shared on September 28.
- 4 Offer onsite penicillin allergy assessment and/or testing to employees and patients claiming an allergy to penicillin.
- 5 Issue a [press release](#) to highlight your participation and specialty by customizing the available NPAD press release template.
- 6 Deliver grand rounds or [penicillin allergy awareness presentations](#) through your medical facility and/or community.
- 7 Post #NPAD18 [social media messages](#).
- 8 Share information with your facility, state and regional medical and pharmacy boards through e-mail or [newsletters](#).
- 9 Listen and participate to [online penicillin allergy education](#).
- 10 Add a [NPAD Web Button](#) to your website to let patients and providers know you support the campaign.
